UNITED KINGDOM REGISTERED DESIGNS

WHY APPLY?

Registering your design gives you the exclusive right to the design in the UK for up to 25 years.

It may help you prevent others benefiting from your investment and could be a valuable asset to your business.

THINGS TO CONSIDER:

The design can be for all or part of any product resulting from the lines, contours, colours, shape, texture, or materials of the product or its ornamentation, provided that the design is not dictated only by how the product works.

The design must be new and create a different overall impression from that of any previous designs.

When applying to register your design we can request publication of the application to be deferred for up to 12 months if you do not wish to disclose the design to the public or your competitors right away.

You can apply for more than one design in your application provided the designs relate to the same type of product. We can help you decide what to register.
